COACH'S CORNER

As most of you have already heard, U.S. Soccer has introduced several changes to the format that will begin in the Fall of 2016. First, there are changes to the number of players on the field.

U8s will play 4v4 with no goalkeepers.

U9s and U10s will play 7v7.

U11s and U12s will play 9v9.

U13 and up will continue to play 11v11.

The field dimensions will also change, as well as some other small aspects of the rules, including duration of games.

Secondly, the age groups will change. This is where many people are concerned. U.S. soccer is changing the age groups to Calendar Birth Year. They will no longer be using the August 1st cutoff date. They will be using January 1 – December 31. This will occur at the national, regional and state levels. State Cup, President's Cup, Buckeye Premier and tournaments have adapted the new rules for the Fall of 2016.

Starting this Winter, we will change Club Training to a Birth Year Model. (i.e. all 2004's will train together) This will give us a jump start on how the players will match up for the future. We will then determine what is best for the Club, each team and, most importantly, decide what is best for our players, individually.
